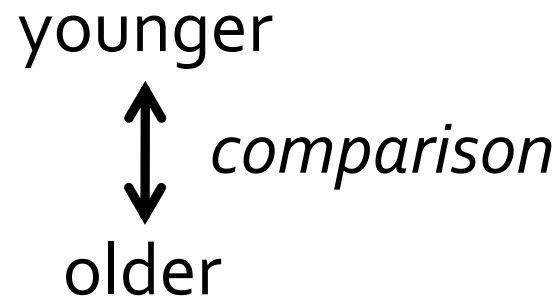

- Cross-sectional (between-subjects) Design



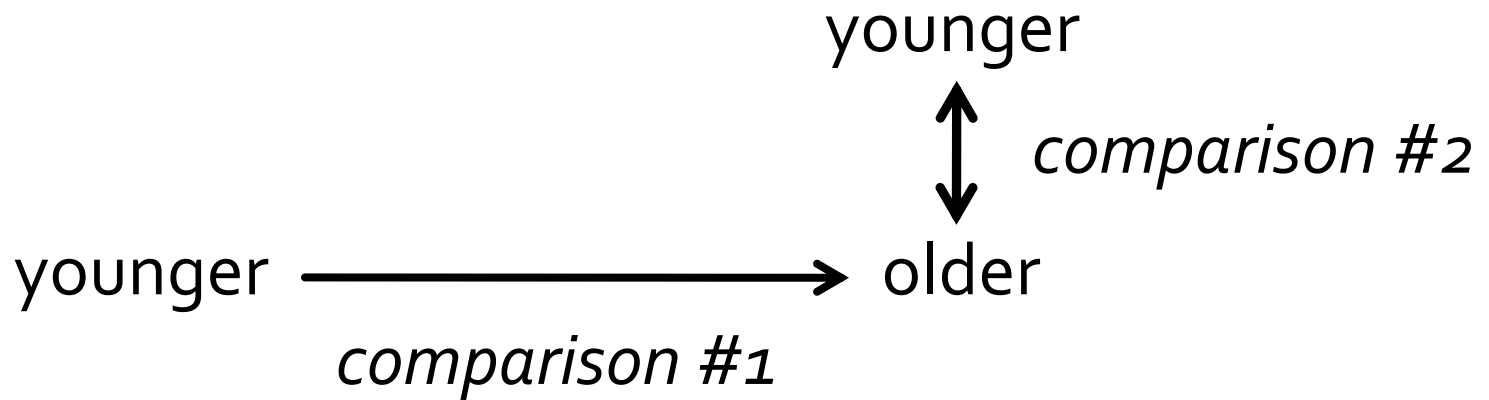
# Aging Research

*comparison*

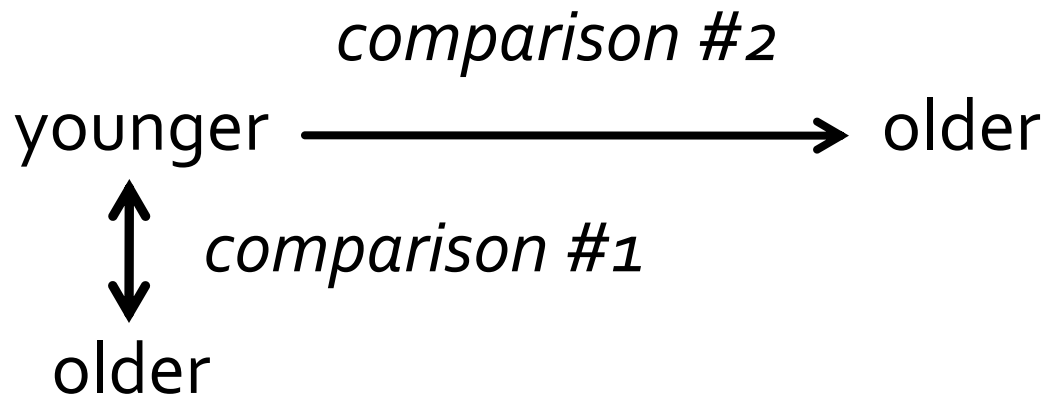
# Aging Research

- Hybrid Design 1



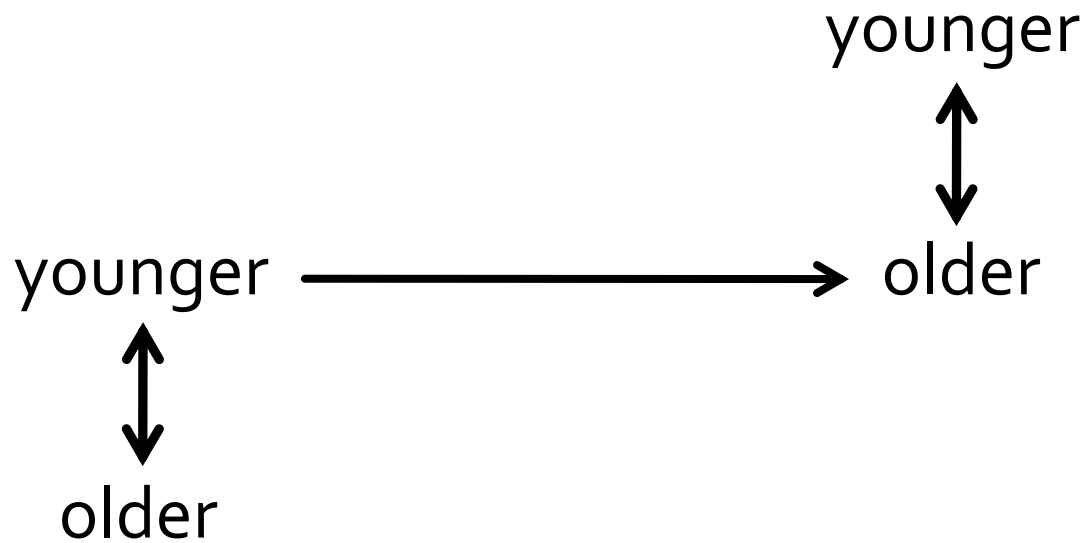
# Aging Research

measure at only two times, not the full lag apart  
use many groups, spaced across the age range,  
but with many specific ages in common
